120 Dr. **I**

Measures 120-121: Drum notation in 4/4 time. Measure 120 is a whole rest. Measure 121 has a snare eighth note followed by a bass drum eighth note, then a snare quarter note and a bass drum quarter note. A '7' is written above the staff. Accents (>) are placed over the snare notes.

128 Dr. **4**/**4**

Measures 128-129: Drum notation in 4/4 time. Measure 128 has a snare eighth note followed by a bass drum eighth note, then a snare quarter note and a bass drum quarter note. Measure 129 has a snare quarter note followed by a bass drum quarter note, then a snare eighth note and a bass drum eighth note. Accents (>) are placed over the snare notes.

132 Dr. **4**/**4**

Measures 132-133: Drum notation in 4/4 time. Measure 132 has a snare eighth note followed by a bass drum eighth note, then a snare quarter note and a bass drum quarter note. Measure 133 has a snare quarter note followed by a bass drum quarter note, then a snare eighth note and a bass drum eighth note. Accents (>) are placed over the snare notes.

136 Dr. **4**/**4**

Measures 136-137: Drum notation in 4/4 time. Measure 136 has a snare eighth note followed by a bass drum eighth note, then a snare quarter note and a bass drum quarter note. Measure 137 has a snare quarter note followed by a bass drum quarter note, then a snare eighth note and a bass drum eighth note. Accents (>) are placed over the snare notes.

140 Dr. **4**/**4**

Measures 140-141: Drum notation in 4/4 time. Measure 140 has a snare eighth note followed by a bass drum eighth note, then a snare quarter note and a bass drum quarter note. Measure 141 has a snare quarter note followed by a bass drum quarter note, then a snare eighth note and a bass drum eighth note. Accents (>) are placed over the snare notes.

144 Dr. **4**/**4**

Measures 144-145: Drum notation in 4/4 time. Measure 144 has a snare eighth note followed by a bass drum eighth note, then a snare quarter note and a bass drum quarter note. Measure 145 has a snare quarter note followed by a bass drum quarter note, then a snare eighth note and a bass drum eighth note. Accents (>) are placed over the snare notes.


